Les Gutches, Olympic Training Center Currently Les is working as Director of Program Development for USA Wrestling to help ensure our Grassroots programs throughout the US. During Les' competitive days he was one of our most accomplished wrestlers earning a Gold Medal at the 1997 World Championships as well as making the 1996 Olympic Team, where he placed 7th. During his collegiate days, Les won two NCAA titles ('95 and '96) while wrestling for Oregon State. He also earned the Dan Hodge award as the nation's top college wrestler in 1996. Les has had success at all age levels of wrestling winning Three state titles for South Medford HS, a Silver medal at the 1989 Cadet World Championships, and a Bronze medal at the 1993 Espoir World Championships.



Gary Mayabb, Staley High School. Currently the Head Wrestling Coach at Staley High School, where he has coached since 2008 when the school opened. Previously Coach Mayabb was at Oak Park High School where he had a career record of 127-31-1. While at Oak Park his teams had won 5 State Championships and were ranked nationally on a regular basis. In 2006 they had a remarkable championship run with 9 state finalist which included 5 champions. Coach Mayabb has received numerous coaching awards which includes 9 state and regional COY awards as well as being named USA Wrestling Greco-Roman Coach of the Year. He has also served as a member of the Missouri/USA Wrestling National Coaching Staff.



Travis Pascoe, Arizona State University. Travis is entering his first year as an assistant at ASU. Previously he has coached at Oregon State and Fresno State, after completing his collegiate career at Nebraska University. While at NU Travis was a 4X NCAA qualifier and finished 6th in 2006 at 184 lbs. He finished with 101 collegiate wins. While in high school he was a 3X State Champ competing for Gonzaga Prep in Washington where he compiled a 138-8 record.



Steve Fraser, National Greco-Roman Coach, Coach Fraser has been the USA Wrestling National Coach since 1985. In 2007 he led the USA team to its first World Team Championship in Greco-Roman. In 1984 Steve became the first Greco-Roman Olympic Gold Medalist for the United States. Coach Fraser was a 2X All-American for Michigan as well as a State Champ for Hazel Park High School.

Tim Berrier, Ironwood Ridge High School, Over his career Coach Berrier has been one of our more successful coaches in Arizona. Last year Coach Berrier led the Nightwawks to their first State Championship after two runner-up finishes. Coach Berrier has also had successful stints at Pueblo High School and Salpointe Prep which have garnered him numerous Coach of the Year awards. Tim has coached numerous State champions and state placers during his coaching career. His teams are regularly in the hunt for the team state championship, with all their off-season work.

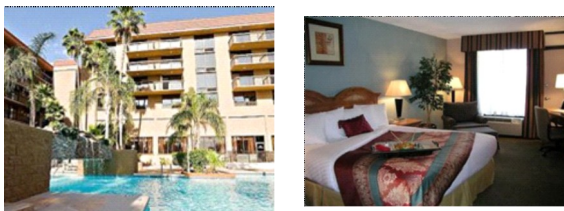

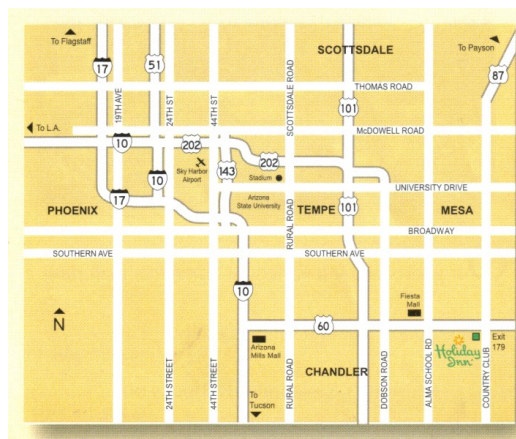
