NCAA RE-DRAWS 157 LBS. BRACKET; DANISHEK MOVES TO MATCH WITH NO. 2 KEMERER

March 10, 2017

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. - The selection committee for the NCAA Wrestling Championships has re-drawn the 157 lbs. bracket, the NCAA announced Friday. As a result of the new seeding, Jake Danishek will now wrestle second-seeded Michael Kemerer (Iowa). He was previously slotted in the pigtail match against Alex Griffin (Purdue), who would've wrestled for a spot against 8-seed Jake Short (Minnesota) in the first round.

An explanation on the decision from the NCAA is as follows:

"We were just informed that Brian Murphy (Michigan) the #10 seed at 157 has to withdraw because of an injury. Brian Murphy will be replaced by Chase Delande (Edinboro) in the 157 bracket. Because Brian Murphy was seeded in the top 16, we will now need to move in our 1st seeded alternate Victor Lopez (Bucknell) who now becomes the #16 seed and re-draw the bracket."

Updated brackets are attached. Brackets are subject to change until the replacement deadline on Sunday, March 12 at 5:00 p.m. ET.
